

# Services for Students at the UT Learning Center

Most students—even those who were very successful in high school—face some academic adjustments when coming to UT. Here's what the UT Learning Center can do to help your students make a successful transition to college.

- **Walk-In Academic Counseling.** During regular office hours (Monday-Friday, 9 am to 5 pm), students can come to the Learning Center without an appointment and talk one-on-one with a Learning Specialist. Typical topics include: test anxiety, time management, procrastination, goal setting, and concentration problems.
- **Appointment Tutoring.** This service provides one-to-one, individualized tutoring for many large entry-level courses, including math, physics, and chemistry. All students are eligible for at least 5 hours of free tutoring. Additional sessions cost \$13.50.
- **Drop-In Tutoring.** Tutors are available to help students with calculus, chemistry, and physics in this group-based tutoring center; many students choose to do their homework in the Drop-In Tutoring Center. Drop-in tutoring is free to all students.
- **Supplemental Instruction.** SI assists students in historically difficult entry-level courses through regularly scheduled, modified forms of discussion sections. These discussion sections are designed to help students master the concepts of an academic course and, at the same time, increase their competency in the learning strategies relevant to the course.
- **Teaching Teams Program.** TTP offers weekly peer-led study groups designed to help students work through course material and prepare for exams in a collaborative environment. The members of the teaching team, including the instructor and study group facilitators, meet regularly to discuss course content and organize the study groups.
- **Peer Academic Coaching.** PAC is designed to help students get the academic results they're seeking. Students agree to meet with a Peer Mentor for an hour each week to discuss and receive guidance on issues such as managing time, prepping for tests, concentrating while reading, and matching study skills to test requirements.
- **Classes and Workshops.** The Learning Center offers a variety of free study strategies and speed reading courses, as well as exam reviews for math and chemistry courses. We also offer short workshops around campus concerning topics such as time management, motivation, and goal setting.
