Dean's Scholars Honors Program Overview:

- Honors Bachelor of Science degree in any College of Natural Sciences major
- Broad-based science degree program: Students take honors courses in at least four disciplines
- Students have access to honors sections of biology, math, chemistry, computer sciences, and physics for majors
- Introduction to research methods
- Topical seminars exclusive to Dean's Scholars
- Numerous co-curricular and leadership activities (Dean's Scholars Student Council, field trips, IM sports teams, faculty lunches, theater productions, distinguished guest lectures...)
- Students do research and write an honors thesis

Advantages:

- Small classes with the best faculty in the College of Natural Sciences
- Accelerated entry into advanced classes
- Greater flexibility in course selection
- More electives than standard degree plans
- Facilitated access to research opportunities
- Participation in a community of scholars
- Priority consideration for on-campus honors housing
- Service and leadership opportunities
- Creates the feeling of a small school with the resources and advantages of a large research university
